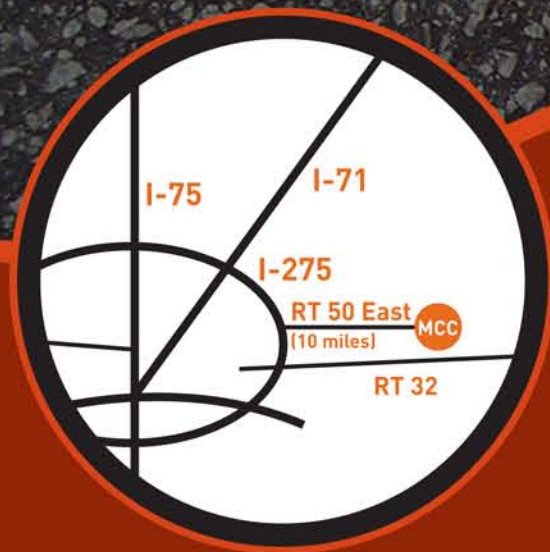

Shifter karts accelerate, brake, and corner in phenomenal fashion and can reach speeds of 90 mph while pulling over 2 lateral g-forces in a corner.

MCC is conveniently located on Rt. 50 in Batavia Ohio, just minutes from I-275. The facility is equipped with a full service club house that includes mens and womens locker rooms, kitchen, dining room, observation deck and kart storage. MCC has a full time staff of experienced racing instructors and mechanics who provide the very best in kart driving instruction and maintenance.

### About the Track

Designed by professionals, the track is a .7 mile, 26 feet wide road course with eight different configurations. The long course features 17 corners and includes a 650 ft main straightaway that leads to 33 degree banking and the downhill esses. There are low, medium, and high speed corners with many opportunities for passing. Wide run-off areas and safety barriers are incorporated and contribute to an exceptionally safe environment. This revolutionary track design gives the sensation of driving a true road course such as Mid-Ohio or Road America.
